Sangamon County Recorder Announces an Honor Rewards Program for Veterans

November 6, 2014, SPRINGFIELD, IL – The Sangamon County Recorder’s Office is excited to announce a new service for our military veterans, known as, Honor Rewards. The Honor Rewards program is a free service that offers military veterans discounts and incentives at local businesses. “We cannot say thank you enough to our men and women who have served in the military”, Sangamon County Recorder Josh Langfelder said. “It is an opportunity for businesses to say thank you to our local military veterans for their service.”

To sign up, all a veteran needs to do is visit www.sangamoncountyrecorder.com, click on the “Honor Rewards” tab and complete the required information under the Veterans Sign-Up link or they can visit the Recorder’s office during business hours and the staff will help them get signed up. In doing so, the military veteran will receive an Honor Rewards ID card. “Not only does the program provide the veteran an ID card but it also encourages them to record their military discharge papers (DD214 form) with the Recorder’s office” Langfelder said, “just like the Honor Rewards program, this service is free of charge to the veteran.” After signing up the veteran can expect to receive their Honor Rewards ID card in the mail within two weeks.

Local businesses and retailers can participate in the service by contacting the Recorder’s office or using the Business Sign-Up link at www.sangamoncountyrecorder.com under the “Honor Rewards tab. By participating, the business name will be listed on the Honor Rewards website for Sangamon County, provided to Veterans who receive an Honor Rewards ID card and also be updated via email to current Honor Rewards members. In addition, the Recorder’s office will provide participating businesses with promotional materials such as door stickers and flyers to promote their involvement.

Currently there are 11 counties, 400 veterans and 125 businesses in Illinois that participate in the Honor Rewards program and that number is continuing to grow. “More and more military veterans and businesses are signing up as information gets out to the community”, Langfelder said. “It is a program which Sangamon County should be proud to be a part.”
